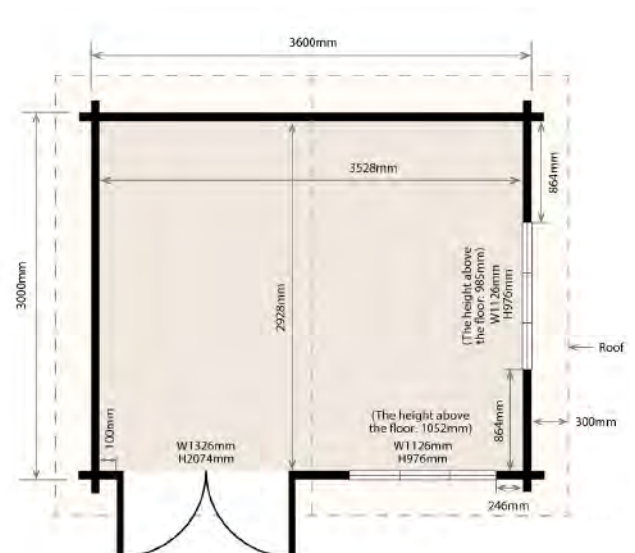

The cabin's doors and windows are positioned to allow for plenty of natural light, allowing you to work, relax and craft in comfort. The aluminium doors and windows are double-glazed with toughened glass. They are secured with tough stainless steel hardware.



Made from kiln-dried FSC certified chemical free Scots pine. The walls are tongue and groove solid 36mm thick timber. This provides natural insulation and strength.

The floor and roof are tongue and groove 18mm Scots pine, completing the all round solid timber look.

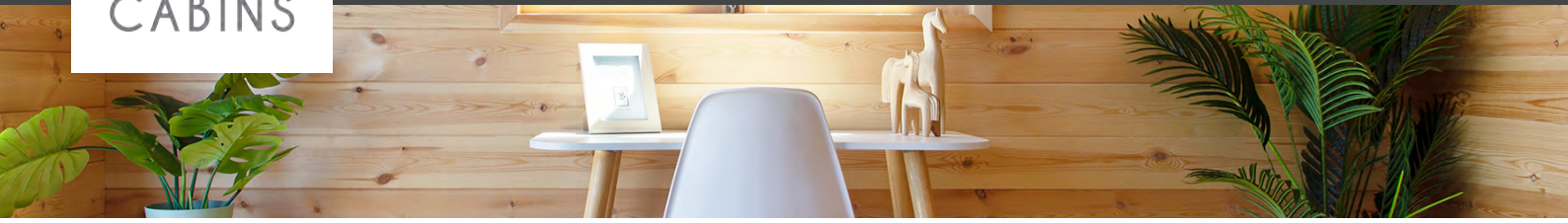
Features

Foundation and Site Information

The cabin must be built on a completely level surface. Lifestyle Cabins recommends pile foundations. A poured concrete slab is also suitable. Other options are available so you should discuss this with a local builder to see what is suitable in your area.





Lifestyle Cabins are supplied in kitset form. They come with a full set of assembly instructions and all of the fittings and fixtures.

It is important to note that assembling one of our cabins is not something you should attempt if you have no building or practical experience or inadequate tools. The assembling and understanding of the instruction manual can be quite confusing for the inexperienced.

You must allow sufficient time, assistance, and resource to complete the job properly.

If you choose this option it can be very fulfilling as many of our customers tell us that assembling one of these cabins is one of the more satisfying things they have done.

Most of our customers DIY these cabins themselves.

If you feel this is not a job that you want to tackle yourself then it is best to arrange for a contractor to complete it for you. Any skilled handyman or builder is able to complete this project.

Electrical

Lifestyle Cabins are straightforward to add lights, power outlets etc. We recommend wooden capping to keep with the wooden rustic appearance of the cabin. Any qualified electrician is able to complete this for you.

Underfloor insulation, roof insulation, decking, etc.

All are possible. Simply DIY or ask your contractor to discuss directly. Be sure to check with the local regulations if there are any restrictions in your area.
